



York is served by a railway station on Britain's East Coast Mainline, with fast trains from London and Edinburgh. There are local suburban rail services around Yorkshire, as well as Trans-Pennine trains from Liverpool and Manchester. The coach drop off point for most national coach carriers is outside the main entrance to York railway station.

Travel from the railway station to the apartment is most easily achieved by taxi, though for those who might like to walk, the route is straightforward and about 850m/12-15 minutes on foot.

Taxi. Ask the taxi driver to take you to Bootham Row. As you turn into Bootham Row from Bootham, ask to be dropped adjacent to the ATM provided by Sainsburys. A drop off in Bootham Row saves you having to cross any roads, and enables the taxi driver to easily turn around. Keeping Sainsburys on your right, go around to the front of the building, where you will find the entrance to the Aspire building.

Walking. On exiting York railway station, turn left and head north-east along Station Road. Stay on the left-hand pavement; you will pass the Royal York Hotel on your left, followed by a short downhill section, over one set of traffic lights. 200m from the station, the road bends to the right just before a second set of traffic lights; you should stay on the left-hand pavement as it goes under the city walls (A) and turns left, going up and over Lendal Bridge. At the end of Lendal Bridge, follow Museum Street uphill, passing the entrance to the Yorkshire Museum and Gardens (B) and the city Library on your left. At the end of Museum Street, at the next set of traffic lights, turn left into St Leonard's Place. Stay on the left-hand pavement as the road curves around to your right, passing Exhibition Square and the Art Gallery on your left (C), and the Theatre Royal and Bootham Bar on your right. At the next set of traffic lights, the pavement passes under the Abbey gateway (C), where you should turn left into Bootham. Use the pedestrian crossing to cross to the right-hand side of the road. About 50m ahead you will see the Sainsburys Local supermarket, just beyond the turning for Bootham Row. The entrance to the Aspire building is next to Sainsburys (D).
